Since inception, both funds have achieved a performance of 35.8% * and 23.6% ** respectively. In February 2018, Citywire rated all three managers with AAA, the highest rating. Additionally, both funds have received a 5-star rating from Morningstar. In addition, the MainFirst Emerging Markets Corporate Bond Fund Balanced has been awarded with the Euro-FundAward.
